Midstream Incentive Requirements

- Boiler and water heater incentives are exclusively available through program-participating distributors.
- Contractors can purchase program-eligible boilers and water heaters from participating distributors at regular price, with an incentive credited back to their account when they validate and submit the application to the distributor.
- Contractors must provide the following product information to their participating distributor on the streamlined application, which only takes a few minutes to complete:
 - Model/serial number
 - Installation date
 - Installation address
 - Invoice number from the distributor
