Details of this program, including incentive levels, are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice. This application with required documentation must be received within 30 days of installation completion and within six months of the HPwES home energy assessment. Funds for incentives are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Incentive amounts are valid through December 31, 2012. Please allow six to eight weeks for incentive processing. ELIGIBILITY: This offer is valid for Consumers Energy residential customers applying only through Consumers Energy Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program who are Consumers Energy natural gas and/or electric customers. Participants must be Consumers Energy residential customers who have either electric heat, or central air conditioning, for electric customers; or central gas furnaces or gas boilers for natural gas customers. Participant homeowners must use a Consumers Energy Trade Ally contractor that is an active participating contractor in the Consumers Energy Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program.
